
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ABOUT

He spent nearly 30 years at The Wall Street Journal, where he was publisher and also served as Executive Vice President of Dow Jones.

He is an advisor and consultant to media and technology companies. He is a director of public companies Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, Marin Software, and NextDigital (Hong Kong), as well as private companies Business Insider and Blurb. He serves on several early-stage advisory boards.
